	I trust this letter finds you well during these difficult times. At present, I
	am blessed with good health and spirit. I am writing to see if you received
	my article. I was told that the letter got lost. I was upset, but I got over it by
	being positive and re-writing my article. I sent it a second time, but I still
	have not heard back from you. Here at Calhoun State prison, the virus is
	bad. A lot of staff have tested positive for the virus. Four wardens also tested
	posítíve, and one warden díed.
	Because of the virus, we are not allowed to go outside or have visits with
	our families. About 120 of us are living in the gym for protection from the
	other inmates who have the virus. I manage my anxiety, first of all, by
	praying to God. Also, I exercise in the small space where we are permitted. I
	run and walk around. I do push-ups and sít-ups. I wear my mask, keep all
	of my belongings clean, and keep distance from others. I write letters to my
	friends and family so they receive my love, care, and concern. I pray for
	my family and the nation as well.
	Cynthía, behind these walls, we men endure all kinds of viruses. In
	one second, life is over and gone. Physically, emotionally, and spiritually,
	death and disaster are common among us. Looking around me, I see many
	who need help to make it through. I reach out and give the fellowship of con-
	versation. There is a lot that I can't do, but there is a lot that's possible for
	me to do, too.
	In closing, I wait to hear from you. God bless.
